

NFMHA A/P Policy

House League players may play as an affiliate player provided;

- a) They have participated in try-outs
- b) does not interfere with regular scheduled games or practices and be a minimum 2-hour interval between games.

The proper procedure for calling up a player as an affiliate is as so:

The coach wanting to recruit a player must first get permission from the player's coach and complete an Offer of Affiliation form. All forms must be signed and approved by the President. The forms are then uploaded onto Hockey Canada and the player must then be approved on the roster. There is a minimum 24 hour period for roster approval that is enforced by the OMHA.

The skate fee is \$15 and must be paid in advance, prior to the A/P being used. The sum of \$60 must be given to the NFMHA office for 4 skates. Once these skates are used, another \$60 must be provided. Any remaining balance at the end of the year will be refunded to the parents.

Practices are free.

The coach wanting to call up an A/P must first tell their convenor of their intentions at least 48 hours prior to the requested date. The convenor will then speak to the player's coach's convenor who will check with the coach if that is allowable.

At **no time** does the coach have the right to directly contact any player. Everything must go through the convenor.
